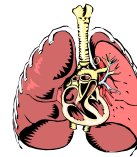

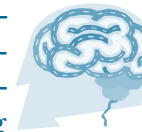
## Program Description

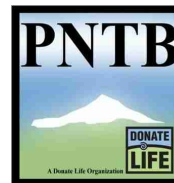

**Eric W. Palmer, MD**, works at Medford Radiological Group, in Medford, Oregon and is currently the Medical Director at Providence Medford Medical Center.

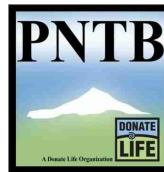
